The designer included well-placed windows to capture gorgeous ocean views from all areas of the kitchen. Long runs of counter space and base cabinets make up for the lack

of upper cabinets due to the windows.

The island is functional from all sides and includes an open shelf, deep drawers, trash compactor, wine refrigerator and wine storage cabinets. The end of the island near the refrigerator houses a prep/bar sink. The weathered look of glazed red birch cabinetry provides the shabby chic look the owners were aiming for.
