The goal: Bring some WOW factor into a New England colonial home. The mood desired was contemporary yet in a subdued format with clean, uncluttered lines. The existing stainless steel refrigerator worked well with the natural Cherry cabinets and Atlantic Black granite.

An induction cooktop is perfect for the corner application with a one-of-a-kind tiled backsplash that incorporates glass tiles in the colors of fire and smoke inlaid into full height Atlantic Black granite. A modernistic stainless steel hood becomes part of the artistic design.

The large island serves as the prep/clean up center on one end and party central on the other. The display cabinet is visible from the foyer. The business end includes an under mount sink and dishwasher. The party end is complete with entertainment sink and under counter icemaker. The contemporary look is completed with a large tempered glass top supported by 3-inch chrome uprights. The pendant lighting and custom counter stools aid in creating a festive atmosphere.
