a family kitchen with style

This new kitchen was designed by award-winning kitchen designer David Annand for a formal home in an elegant neighborhood in Concord, Massachusetts. The homeowners wanted an open concept for this area yet they also wanted their kitchen to reflect a distinctive style and grace all its own. They requested that the primary kitchen sink be concealed from the open area view.

Subtle elegance with architectural interest is achieved by staggered wall heights and depths topped by 5-inch crown molding. The 48-inch custom hood over the cooktop has a special 8-inch stacked crown. Extensive use of fluting and wainscoting complement the high quality of the home.

The use of granite offers a dramatic effect for the room with a full granite backsplash behind the cooktop. The primary sink space was concealed from the open area view by raising the height of the glass-front display cabinet. The counter was then dropped back to normal height for the snack bar and secondary sink. The granite counter on the

display cabinet sweeps around to form a windowsill in front of the sink. This area provides a convenient buffet and bar area for informal entertaining and family gatherings.

Other practical and convenient features of this kitchen include a warming drawer placed under the cooktop, a quadruple waste separator to accommodate a large family in their recycling efforts, and a special desk area with full extension file drawers and cubbyholes for each member of the family.

A butler's pantry, library, master and other baths in the home were also designed by Dream Kitchens as part of this remodeling project. Dream Kitchens increasingly designs for more specialty areas in clients' homes, often including custom furniture in these designs, in order to meet specific needs, tastes and styles. ♦

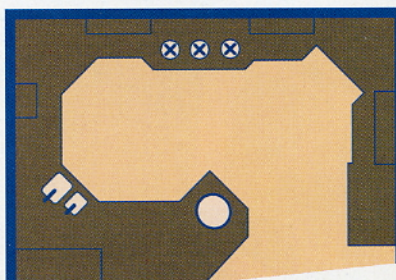
Glass front display cabinet blocks sink from view, quadruple separator aids in recycling.
