"Do whatever you want, just make it better," was the request these homeowners made of Jacqueline Lambert of Dream Kitchens. While all of the other rooms in this beautiful home had been remodeled, the one room which had remained unchanged was the kitchen.

The designer's first suggestion was to take down the room's interior wall. This created a spacious area that included a sunroom, where the couple spent most of their time. With the wall removed, there was room for a spacious peninsula, including a work area, sink and snack bar. The area fac-

ing the sunroom and the kitchen provided the perfect spot for glass door storage of dishware and glasses.

The dishwasher was placed to the left of the sink, and the cabinet to the right houses a dual waste bin for recycling. A large cabinet to the left of the dishwasher has roll-out drawers to allow easy access for casserole dishes, large serving bowls, or for whatever else may require additional storage.

The frameless cabinetry is made of maplewood with a white glaze, softening the look of the kitchen. In fact, staying with neutral tones throughout the kitchen is exactly what the client wanted. It allows them to incorporate colors from the sunroom, or even use the Oriental motif from the dining room. "With this new design," the homeowners rave, "we now enjoy our home more than ever before, and we have lived here for 25 years!" ♦
