For storage needs, Smith placed a new pantry opposite the island and situated cabinetry all around the kitchen. Smith also installed recessed lights, as well as pendants over the island, for times when more dramatic ambiance is desired.

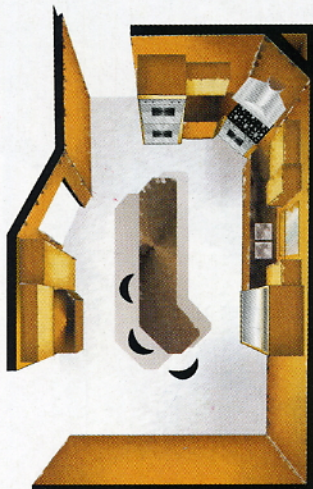
